Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 5/12/2023

PUBLIC FORUM

There were 5 members of the public present.

MINUTES

The minutes of 7<sup>th</sup> November 2023 Council meeting were accepted unanimously.

MATTERS ARISING

a) TELEPHONE BOX PAINTING

The Chairman reported that the painting of the interior of the box had not been completed because the door was found to need repair. The work would be completed in the spring.

b) ABANDONED FURNITURE IN LAY BY

It was noted that Cornwall Council had removed the abandoned furniture.

c) CORONATION TREE PLANTING

The Chairman informed the Council that he and Cllrs Warne and Bunkum had successfully planted the Coronation tree for which thanks were given by all.

PLANNING PERMISSION

The Council approved planning application PA23/05611. First floor extension and loft conversion at 7 Briars Ryn for Mr and Mrs Simon and Sara Dolley

FINANCE

The Council approved the following payments; £372 to Duchy Defibrillators for maintenance, £220 to the Village Hall for rental and £5 to Cllr Dolley for mulch for the Coronation tree.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

1. TROUGH IN THE ROW

The Clerk was asked to contact Cornwall Highways to seek clarification regarding whether or not, the placing of a stone trough on the public highway was permissible. It was also noted that a Christmas tree in the trough obscured the street name.

2. WEB SITE MAINTENANCE

The Council decided to seek a replacement volunteer to maintain the Council web site owing to the departure of Mr. Wheeley who had carried out the task for many years.

3. POT HOLES

Cllr Johnson reported that Pillaton residents had complained to Cornwall Highways about the pot holes and bad road surface on the road to Landrake (noting that this was outside the Pillaton parish Boundary).

4. VILLAGE MAP

The Council were aware of the issue regarding moving the village map and the lack of support, but in the absence of any official approach to the Council it was decided that no action would be taken at this time.
