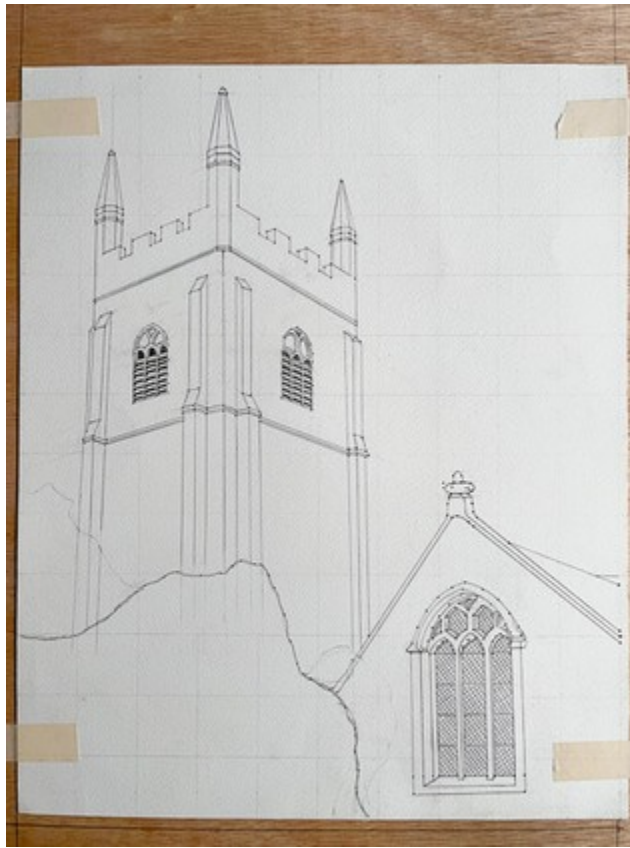


Church Lightning Strike Mosaic - January 2023

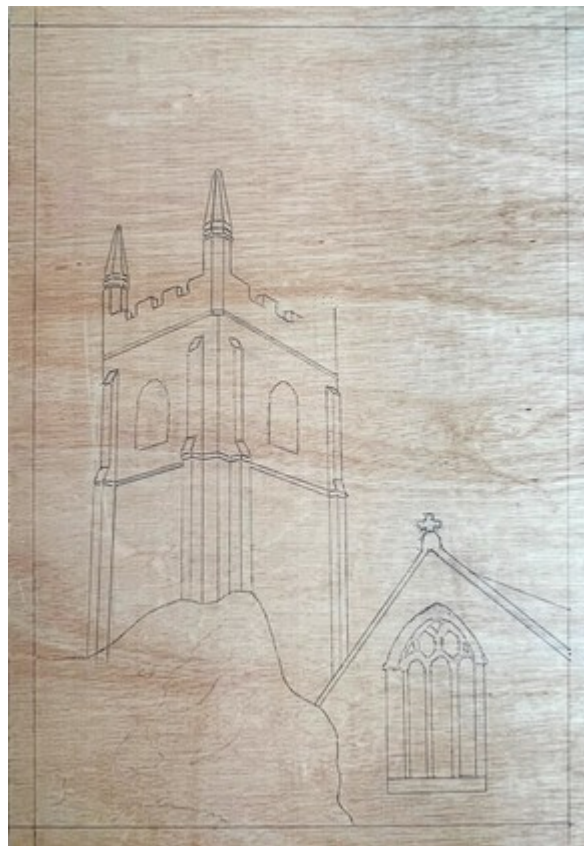
*The images below show stages in the creation of the mosaic plaque made by Richard Warwick to commemorate the tenth anniversary of the lightning strike on Pillaton's St. Odolphus church on the night of 21st January 2013.

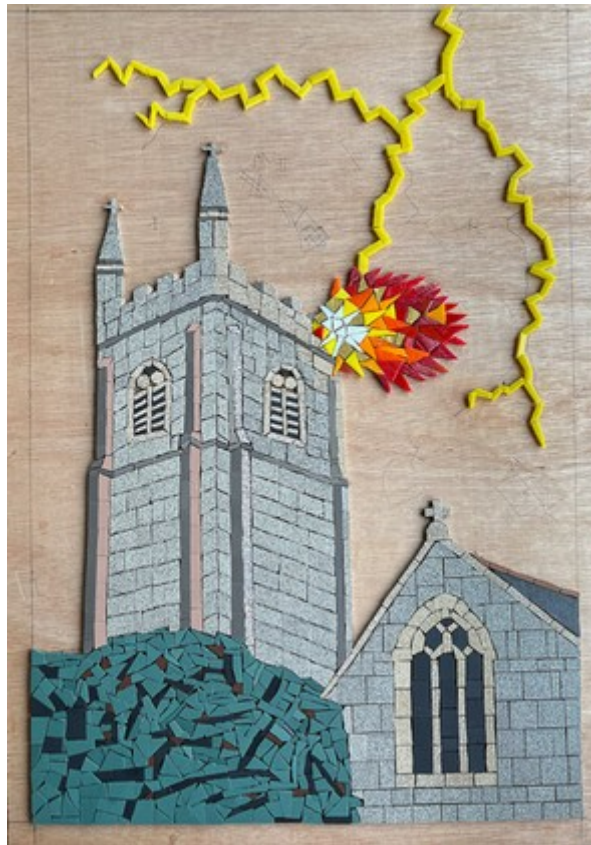
(1) Richard's initial photograph used as the basis for the design



(2) Les Wyatt's full-sized base drawing on paper, pricked through to the baseboard



(3) The pencil outline on the baseboard



(4) Gluing of the ceramic and glass mosaic tiles onto the baseboard



(5) More mosaic pieces, including a fragment of roof-slate salvaged from the debris of the explosion, now in place



*(6) The complete and grouted mosaic in the frame made by Roger Warne and ready for display in the church.
