

## **Chairman's Annual Report – Pillaton Parish Council 7<sup>th</sup> May 2024**

### **Council activities**

5 Planning Applications supported.

Landulph Parish Councillor advised Pillaton PC of the new red bus service (Pillaton to Saltash), once a week service to run for a year.

The Police did not support the installation of a speed recorder camera in the village to monitor 30mph. Data revealed that 485 vehicles travelled under 30mph.

Councillors attended a public meeting in Liskeard to consider the 'Mayor for Cornwall' option.

Parochial Church Council (PCC) met with the Cornwall tree surveyor to check the safety of the Beech tree in the churchyard, overhanging the village hall. The tree was deemed safe though the surveyor advised that the PCC should check the tree every three months for signs of deterioration / damage and take photographs of the tree. There is currently a small split on the east side of the main trunk of the tree. The PCC to keep the Parish Council apprised of developments.

### **Local matters**

Fly-tipping in Pillaton – issue resolved with Cornwall Council.

Parish Council informed Cornwall Highways of potholes in the village requiring repair.

Clapper Bridge / public footpath – stiles need repair on Clapper path.

Telephone box repainted and refurbished.

Clapper Bridge lintel(s) repair required and instruction sign limiting width of bridge.
